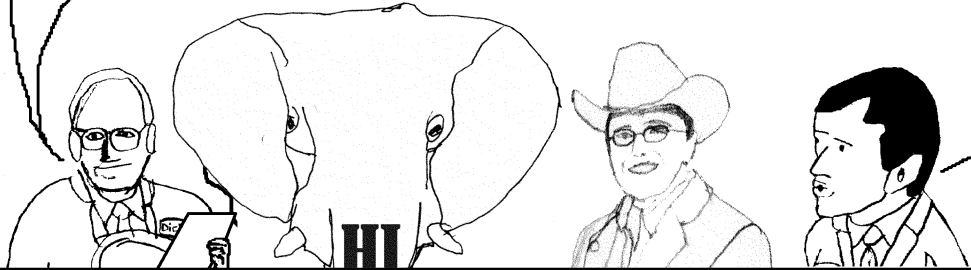


I'm worried. Everyone is predicting a Democratic victory in both houses of Congress.
