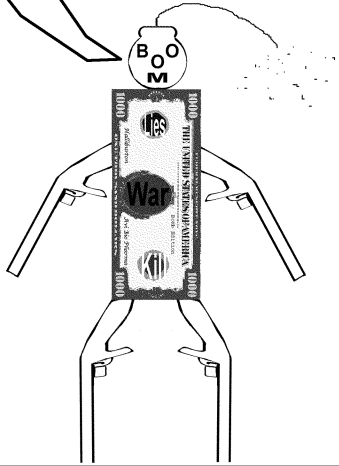
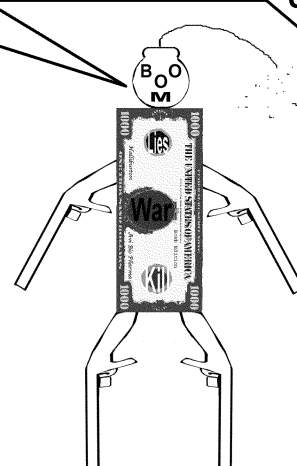


I don't agree with Reverend Wright. I find his outrageous remarks extreme and reprehensible. I sat in his pews for 20 years in total shock over the offensive things he said.

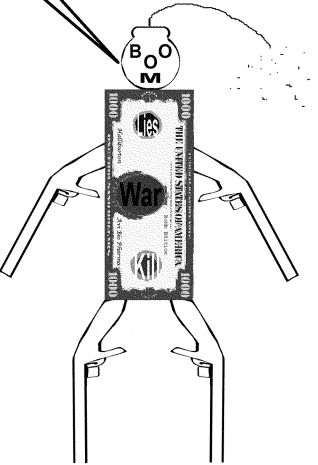
